<u>Watsonville Community Band</u>: a 50-piece band: a 20-piece band Watsonville Community Band has been performing locally and abroad since 1947. The band performs at many community events – in many communities – throughout the year. It also hosts annual Spring and Winter Concert series with performances around the Central Coast. Watsonville Community Band is one of the few adult community bands in the United States that performs in concerts and parades on a regular basis, with all performances free to the public. Members range in age from 14 – 90 and include men and women from all walks of life from five California counties: Santa Cruz, Monterey, San Benito, Santa Clara, San Mateo, and Calaveras. No one receives any payment for their efforts on behalf of the band, including the Conductor and Business Manager. Watsonville Community Band is offered as a free class with the Watsonville/Aptos/Santa Cruz Adult Education program and welcomes everyone, including qualified students from local middle and high schools.
