About the Performers

The Bard and the Bird: Chris and Holly Baldwin are currently living in Monterey, California but are natives to Atlanta, Georgia with 25 years of experience performing around the United States and Asia. Playing Irish, American folk, 90s, 80s, and country songs, their wide range and singalongs offer an entertaining atmosphere. They have played over 400 live shows, getting their start in the Deep South of Georgia, then playing everywhere from Texas, Maryland, and South Dakota, to California, Hawaii, and South Korea.
