Wharf Walks

“From Sea to Table: The History of Fishing for

Sardines, Abalone, Calamari, Salmon, Crab and More on Monterey Bay,”

a Wharf Walk, will be offered by Tim Thomas Saturday, May 6, from 10 a.m. to noon.

Given the abundant sea life of the Monterey Bay, every group of inhabitants — from the native Rumsien Ohlone and the whalers from the Azores, to the squid fishermen from China, salmon fishermen and abalone divers from Japan, and Sicilians fishing sardines — has heavily relied upon local fisheries, and Thomas will talk about their history and offer a tour at Fisherman’s Wharf in Monterey/
