

## The fascinating history of whaling in the Monterey Bay

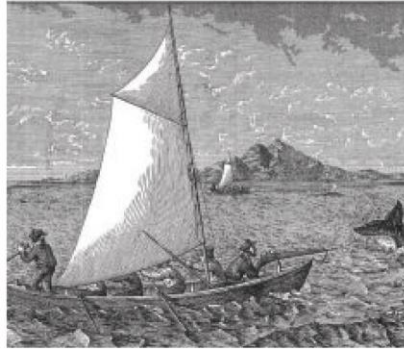
